WHAT IS THE PROJECT ?

FACIS is a project in order to **develop partnership between islands of Europe on topics related to : Facilitation, Leadership, Team-building, NGO cooperation and good practices in the field of NGO management.** Aim is to experiment different Group Facilitation Methods and empower youth facilitators in implementing quality training activities using participatory methods;

Language : Activities will be in English.

- To share and exchange participatory methods and good practices in order to improve teamwork and group creativity;

- To provide the opportunities for networking with partners interested in participative approaches;
- To find creative ways to involve facilitators in non-formal education and enhance motivation. AIMS: The main aim of this training is to strengthen the role of youth work and Non Formal Education in employability by training new 24 Facilitators in the field of Non Formal Education and Experiential Learning participants have the chance to further develop their competences as a facilitator.

It is focus to participants who have previously participated to youth exchange and are **willing to learn about group leader role and/or trainer role focusing on team dynamics**. Aim is to work with youth target using Erasmus+ Program. Understand English is recommended.
